Conventionally, as a wheel speed sensor of a vehicle, there is known a device which detects rotation speed of a wheel by inserting a wheel speed sensor into a space formed between a wheel and a vehicle body. The conventional device includes: a wheel-side member which is located on a side of the wheel which is opposite to a side of the vehicle body; a wheel-side member-side member which is located on a side of the vehicle body opposite to a side of the wheel; and a fastening member which fastens the wheel-side member and the wheel-side member-side member, the wheel-side member being formed into a predetermined shape, the wheel-side member being fixed to a rim portion of the wheel, the wheel-side member having a flange portion which is formed into a planar shape, the fastening member being fixed to a vehicle body-side member portion of the wheel-side member, the vehicle body-side member portion having a plurality of bolts provided on a surface thereof which is opposite to a surface thereof on which the flange portion is formed, the plurality of bolts being passed through holes formed in the vehicle body-side member portion and engaged with the vehicle body-side member portion (see, for example,
